WHO?

WHERE?

GKI operates within systems defined by a specific problem space (e.g., post harvest food loss) or geography (e.g., Rwanda).

COLLABORATIVE INNOVATION:

The act of combining efforts and sharing complementary resources with partners to create, test, and implement innovative ideas. Disproportionately, transformational innovation—that which yields novel vaccines, new transportation alternatives, new markets, etc.—emerges at the intersection between different disciplines, cultures, and sectors. GKI enables success at the intersection by enabling productive, collaborative, inclusive partnerships, networks, and organizations.

INDIVIDUALS



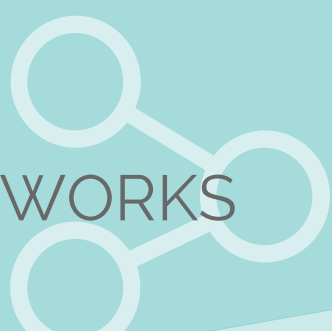
Individuals attain Collaborative Innovation skills and apply them when taking action on global development challenges
